Friends of InterShelter: We received great news yesterday on one of several of our projects to help the over 2 million homeless victims of the quake and the total rebuilding of the infrastructure of Haiti. Congress passed an additional \$2BB this week to add to the \$15BB previously pledged by The UN and world community to help with this enormous task. These funds are about to be committed for the first time to the effort. We have strong support from both the US and Haitian leadership and are hopeful this will translate into support from The International Haitian Reconstruction Committee, (IHRC), who have been charged with administering this massive long term project.

We, at InterShelter, are committed to do all we can to assist the people of Haiti, and those involved in the re-construction, with the next generation of transitional housing, MASH style triage clinics, classrooms, offices, remote police HQs, communications shacks and instant storage facilities. All in buildings as portable and quickly erected as tents that are hurricane and earthquake proof when constructed properly. In addition, our SolarDomes can be totally off the grid and powered by one of Haiti's few unlimited natural resources.....it's intensely hot sun. We stand ready to ramp up our US facilities, which can already produce 40,000 units over the next 12 months. We also plan to build additional production capabilities in Haiti and The Dominican Republic to provide our revolutionary buildings to the whole Caribbean and Latin American markets.

This is going to be an exciting next couple years being part of this global effort. We stand ready to do all we can to help! Best regards to all and Hope for Haiti!
